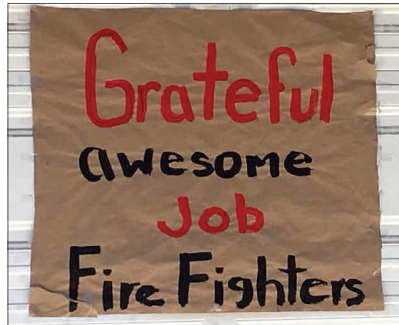


## Our community is grateful for our heroic Corona Fire Department

The **Corona Fire Department (CFD)** was first formed in 1898. While the basic mission of protecting lives and property has remained the same, the manner in which that mission is achieved has been evolving and becoming more capable ever since. From citizens selfishly volunteering to extinguish fires with buckets of water to the professionals of today who have sophisticated equipment, policies and practices to handle just about any emergency, change and improvement in practice has been a constant. A significant period of department history was in the late 1960s and 1970s when the citizens of Corona voted on and passed a Grant measure to modernize the one station department to better protect our rapidly growing community.
